#### Advent, the time of waiting!

The church season of Advent is the time of waiting for Jesus, waiting to celebrate His birth, and waiting for His second coming.

Waiting, hoping, anticipating. This last year I can understand the waiting and hoping. For far too long we had to put up those angry, mean political ads. Not everyone is happy with the election, but I believe most if not all are happy with the end, (no strike that) temporary end of the political ads.

As we will hear on Christ the King Sunday, no matter who is elected president, Christ is King. Christ is King forever and King in giving us a forever with God in heaven.
